EYFS – Online Safety

Lesson 1	
Learning Objective	To be able to explain what it means to own digital content.
Declarative Knowledge	To know that my work on the computer belongs to me and other people's work belongs to them.
Key Vocabulary	Mini mash, digital, content, work, belongs.

Lesson 2	
Learning Objective	To be able to explain what 'private' means when using technology.
Declarative Knowledge	To know what it means for something to be private.
Key Vocabulary	Private, technology, strangers, tell, 2Quiz.

Lesson 3	
Learning Objective	To be able to express how it feels to be uncomfortable with something.
Declarative Knowledge	To know how my body feels when I am not comfortable with something.
Key Vocabulary	Online safety, uncomfortable, upset, worried.

Lesson 4	
Learning Objective	To be able to name 5 people who can help with negative feelings.
Declarative Knowledge	To know who can help me when I am feeling worried.
Key Vocabulary	Helping, feelings, negative, worried, technology, adults, trusted adults, uncomfortable.

Lesson 5	
Learning Objective	To be able to think about how to show kindness to others.
Declarative Knowledge	To know how to be kind to others.
Key Vocabulary	Kind, technology, mashcams.

Lesson 6	
Learning Objective	To begin to be aware of the impact of a lot of screen time.
Declarative Knowledge	To know how to choose activities in my free time that help me to be healthy.
Key Vocabulary	Purple mash, balancing time, healthy, activities.

Lesson – SCARF PSHE	
Learning Objective	To know how to keep safe online.
Declarative Knowledge	- To know about activities that are safe to do on electronic devices. - To know what to do and who to talk to if they feel unsafe online.
Key Vocabulary	Safe, online, unsafe.
