Good morning everyone. Happy Thursday!

Following on from yesterday's post, today is all about the start of the day.

Day 11 - the start of the day

The main gates and the small Litchurch Lane gate will open at 8:20am.

EYFS children and Y1 children will go straight into their classrooms.

Y2 - Y6 will stay on the playground until the whistle blows at 8:40am. They will be supervised by school staff.

Learning will commence at 8:45am. To allow all children to get to their classrooms, put their belongings away and be ready to learn, we'll be closing the gates at 8:40am. Any children arriving after this time will be marked as late.

As a primary school, we're very lucky to have a car park. And we know that ours gets busy. If you choose not to use our breakfast club, then there is a 20 minute window to drop your child off at school - between 8:20am and 8:40am.

Parents have three options:

1. Park at City Gate and walk up to enter through our main gate (this is a short 5 minute walk)
2. Park at Litchurch Lane and walk to enter through our small gate (this is a short 5 minute walk)
3. Drive up to the gate where a member of staff will escort your child out of the car

EYFS parents are able to walk with their children to the classrooms for the first week to aid with their transition 😊.

I strongly advise parents to consider our Early Bird breakfast club...it really is a fantastic offer! 🌸

As always, I ask for your patience at this busy time of the day. My priority remains the safety of our school community and I'm confident that I'll have your support with making this work.
